IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the salaries of the governor, secretary of state, the heads of departments, and the judges of the supreme and superior courts; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.20.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.20.010. ANNUAL SALARY OF GOVERNOR. The annual salary of the governor is \$27,500 [\$25,000] during his first four years and \$30,000 during any succeeding years he serves whether or not they are consecutive. The salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

* Sec. 2. AS 39.20.030. ANNUAL SALARY OF SECRETARY OF STATE.

The annual salary of the secretary of state is \$20,000 [\$18,000]. The salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

* Sec. 3. AS 39.20.080 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.20.080. SALARIES OF DEPARTMENT HEADS. The head of each principal executive department of the state upon appointment and qualification is entitled to an annual salary established by the governor. The salary of each department head may not exceed the amount set opposite titles listed below:

15 * Sec. 4. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

16 (a) The chief justice shall receive \$25,000 [\$23,500]
17 annually, and each associate justice shall receive \$24,000
18 [\$22,500] annually as compensation. The compensation is
19 payable monthly in 12 equal installments. Compensation of
20 the chief justice or of an associate justice shall not be
21 diminished during his term of office, unless by general law
22 applying to all salaried officers of the state.

23 * Sec. 5. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

24 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$21,000
25 [\$19,000] annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12
26 equal installments. The compensation of a judge shall not
27 be diminished during his term of office, unless by general
28 law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

29 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect July 1, 1965.
