SENATE BILL NO. 154

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the employment of resi-  
dent labor in the harvesting and preliminary  
processing of fur seal and sea otter; and  
providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to  
read:

Sec. 23.10.500. USE OF RESIDENT LABOR FOR CERTAIN  
ACTIVITIES. A contractor employing labor for the harvesting  
of fur seal and sea otter and the preparation for shipment of  
their pelts must employ no less than 95 per cent of the labor  
force involved from among the residents of the harvesting  
area or the indigenous residents of the harvesting area  
living in adjoining areas.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
