IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the time a child must be abandoned before an order terminating parental rights is entered; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.10.080(c)(3)(B) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(B) the child has been abandoned for a period of not less than six months by

(i) both parents, or

(ii) the surviving parent, or

(iii) one parent if the other has been

deprived of custody and visitation rights;

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day of its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
