5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the travel of legisla-
7 tors; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.15.050 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 24.15.050. TRANSPORTATION. (a) Each member of
11 the legislature is entitled to receive a transportation
12 request form for his travel to and from legislative sessions
13 and authorized meetings and activities of interim committees.
14 If the member does not use the transportation request form
15 he is entitled to the amount of money the state would pay
16 for his airline fare for the same trip. Applications for
17 money payments in place of the transportation request form
18 shall be in writing and subject to the approval of the
19 certifying officer. The certifying officer is the final
20 authority for approving legislative travel and travel pay-
21 ments.

22 (b) A member traveling to or from a ^{legislative} session by air is
23 entitled to have up to 100 pounds of excess personal baggage
24 accompany him. A state transportation request form for
25 excess baggage will be issued to each member requesting it.
26 If a member sends his baggage by freight or parcel post, he
27 may claim reimbursement for the amount actually spent by
28 submitting freight or postal receipts to support his claim
29 but the amount of reimbursement may not exceed the cost of

* Sec. 2. [This Act] is expressly declared to be retrospective
in effect to cover all state legislative travel.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
