6 For an Act entitled: "An Act designating two components of the
7 Alaska National Guard and authorizing the
8 grade of brigadier general for assistant
9 adjutants general; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 26.05.180 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

13 Sec. 26.05.180. HEADQUARTERS STAFF OF ALASKA NATIONAL
14 GUARD. (a) The headquarters Alaska National Guard shall be
15 composed of an Army National Guard Component and an Air
16 National Guard Component. The Army National Guard Component
17 and the Air National Guard Component shall each be commanded
18 by an assistant adjutant general who shall be appointed by
19 the adjutant general with the concurrence of the governor.
20 An assistant adjutant general shall, while holding office,
21 have the grade of brigadier general or such lower grade as
22 the adjutant general may prescribe.

23 (b) The adjutant general may appoint necessary officers,
24 enlisted men, and civilian employees to the headquarters
25 staff.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
