6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the registration and
7 licensing of motor vehicles; changing
8 the fees for registration and licensing;
9 and providing for an effective
10 date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 28.10.200(b)(4) is amended to read:

13 (4) for a motor vehicle, including a motor vehicle
14 pulling a trailer or semi-trailer, designed, used, or main-
15 tained primarily for the transportation of passengers for
16 hire, excepting taxicabs, and excepting buses taxed under
17 (b)(5) of this section, or for the transportation or hauling
18 of property, including a commercial vehicle such as a
19 trailer, semi-trailer, truck, wrecker, tow car, hearse,
20 ambulance, and tractor, a tax based upon the actual unladen
21 weight as established by the manufacturer's advertised
22 weight, or upon the actual weight which the owner has the
23 responsibility of furnishing, subject to the approval of the
24 commissioner or his agent, as follows:

25 4,500 pounds or less \$35;
26 over 4,500 pounds \$1 per
27 wt. or fraction thereof;
28 [3,800 POUNDS OR LESS \$35;
29 3,801 POUNDS AND NOT OVER 12,000 POUNDS . . . 60;

1 12,001 POUNDS AND NOT OVER 18,000 POUNDS 110;
2 18,001 POUNDS AND OVER..... 160;]

3 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.200(b)(6) is amended to read:

4 (6) for a [SMALL] two- or four-wheeled trailer
5 including a boat trailer [,] or small baggage trailer not
6 exceeding a total unladen weight of 4,000 pounds, and all
7 house trailers [TRAILER], \$4;

8 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 28.10.220. VEHICLES USED BY RANCHERS, FARMERS, AND
10 DAIRYMEN SUBJECT TO ANNUAL LICENSE TAX. A tax of \$35 is im-
11 posed on any three motor vehicles, and also on any three
12 trailers if the unladen weight of any trailer is at least
13 4,000 pounds and not over 12,000 pounds, or any combination
14 of them not to exceed three, if they are owned, operated and
15 used by a rancher, farmer and dairyman in the transportation
16 of his own ranch, farm, or dairy products from the point of
17 production to market or to the point of transportation to
18 market, or of supplies, commodities, or equipment used on
19 the ranch, farm or dairy. Not more than one of the three
20 motor vehicles may be used on the highways at any one time.
21 Motor vehicles and trailers licensed under this classifica-
22 tion shall be identified as farm vehicles in accordance with
23 regulations prescribed by the department.

24 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.290 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 28.10.290. TEMPORARY PERMITS. The department may
26 grant a temporary permit to operate a vehicle pending action
27 on the application for registration and issuance of certi-
28 ificate of title, and for use while driving or moving the
29 vehicle on a highway for the sole purpose of (1) taking it

directly to or from a place to be repaired, (2) delivering
it to a junk yard, or (3) placing it in or removing it from
storage. The fee for a temporary permit is \$2 [\$1].
