6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the forfeiture of com-
7 mercial fishing licenses; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.710 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.710. LICENSE FORFEITURE. Upon a first or
12 second conviction of a person for a violation of secs. 440 -
13 720 of this chapter or a federal or state law or regulation
14 for the protection of the commercial fish of the state, the
15 court may, in addition to the penalty imposed by law, forfeit
16 the commercial fishing license of the person for a period of
17 one year. Upon a third conviction, the court may, in
18 addition to the penalty imposed by law, forfeit the com-
19 mmercial fishing license for a period not to exceed three years

20 [THE FORFEITURE OF THE LICENSE FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN
21 THREE YEARS IS MANDATORY]. [A FORFEITURE UNDER THIS SECTION
22 IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON CONVICTION AND NO STAY PENDING
23 APPEAL MAY BE GRANTED.]

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
25 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
