6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liquor purchaser identi-
7 fication cards."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 04.15.063. PERSONS REQUIRED TO HAVE LIQUOR IDENTI-
11 FICATION CARDS. A person between the ages of 21 and 26 who
12 is a purchaser or consumer of alcoholic beverages, shall
13 carry on his person and show on the demand of any licensee or
14 his employee a liquor purchaser identification card. A
15 person over age 26 may request the issuance of a liquor
16 purchaser identification card.

17 Sec. 04.15.064. CARD CONTENTS AND ISSUANCE. The identi-
18 fication card shall be prepared and issued by the Alcoholic
19 Beverage Control Board and shall bear the name, height,
20 weight, color of hair, address, date of 21st birthday,
21 and photograph of the person to whom it is issued. The card
22 shall be laminated. The board may adopt regulations covering
23 the form and issuance of the card and may charge a fee to
24 cover processing costs.

25 Sec. 04.15.065. VIOLATIONS. A person between the ages
26 of 21 and 26 purchasing alcoholic beverages without a liquor
27 purchaser identification card on his person or a person who
28 transfers, alters or defaces the identification card, or who
29 furnishes false information in obtaining the card is in
