For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the treatment of special
7 education pupils under the public school
8 foundation act; and providing an effective

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.17.050(d) is amended to read:

(d) Each district is entitled to the number of

13

teacher units for elementary schools which corresponds to

14

the average daily membership for its elementary schools

15

in the following elementary schedule. Each district is

16

entitled to the number of teacher units for secondary

17

schools which corresponds to the average daily membership

18

for its secondary schools in the following secondary schedule.

19

If a school district has two or more secondary attendance

20

centers, it shall separately compute the allowable number of

21

teacher units for each of its secondary attendance centers

22

which has an average daily membership of 301 or more pupils.

23

Each district is entitled to the number of teacher units for

24

special education which corresponds to the average daily

25

membership for its special education program in the follow-

26

ing special education schedule.

Sec. 14.17.110. COMPUTATION OF AVERAGE DAILY MEMBER-
SHIP ALLOTMENT. The average daily membership allotment of
each district is computed as required by sec. 60 of this
chapter, except that

(1) the estimated average daily membership as
defined by sec. 90 of this chapter is used in place of
average daily membership; and

(2) each exceptional child receiving special
services is counted as two pupils.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1966.
