6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transportation of  
7 exceptional children to and from school."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section  
10 to read:

11 Sec. 14.30.347. TRANSPORTATION OF EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN.  
12 When transportation is required to be provided as part of  
13 special services, exceptional children, whenever practicable,  
14 shall be carried separately from the children attending  
15 regular classes. State reimbursement for transportation of  
16 exceptional children shall be as provided for transportation  
17 of pupils attending regular classes except that eligibility  
18 for reimbursement shall not be subject to restriction based  
19 on the minimum distance between the school and the residence  
20 of the exceptional child.
