BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

11

Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court

12

consists of ten [NINE] judges, two of whom shall be judges

13

in the first judicial district, one of whom shall be judge

14

in the second judicial district, five [FOUR] of whom shall

15

be judges in the third judicial district, and two of whom

16

shall be judges in the fourth judicial district. At the time

17

of submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill

18

a vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council

19

shall also designate the district in which the appointee is

20

to first reside and serve.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1967.
