6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for additional superior
7 court judges in the first and third judicial
8 districts; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court
13 consists of eleven [NINE] judges, three [TWO] of whom shall
14 be judges in the first judicial district, one of whom shall
15 be judge in the second judicial district, five [FOUR] of
16 whom shall be judges in the third judicial district, and
17 two of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district.
18 At the time of submitting the names of nominees to the
19 governor to fill a vacancy on the superior court bench,
20 the judicial council shall also designate the district in
21 which the appointee is to first reside and serve.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1967.
