6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to allow designation of certain  
7 school bus routes as hazardous; and to pro-  
8 vide for transportation of pupils on these  
9 routes without restrictions based on  
10 minimum distance."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 \* Section 1. AS 14.10.070 is amended by adding a new subsec-  
13 tion to read:

14 (c) The school board of a district, or the department  
15 for areas not within school districts, shall designate as  
16 hazardous those routes which cannot be safely traveled by  
17 children not served by school bus. The designation may  
18 recognize hazards that exist only part of the time and in  
19 these instances the designation shall be applicable only dur-  
20 ing the time the hazards are found to exist. The board or  
21 the department shall provide for the transportation of pupils  
22 on routes designated as hazardous. The additional cost of  
23 the transportation in a district shall be shared equally by  
24 the district and the department. Eligibility to receive  
25 school bus service on routes designated as hazardous shall  
26 not be subject to restrictions based on the minimum distance  
27 between established schools and the residences of pupils.
