6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to property exempt from  
7 execution."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 09.35.080(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) the income [EARNINGS] of the judgment debtor  
11 which is due to him or received by him from any source  
12 [RECEIVED FOR HIS PERSONAL SERVICES RENDERED] at any time  
13 within 30 days immediately preceding the levy, but not ex-  
14 ceeding \$350 if he is the head of a family, and the amount  
15 of \$200 if he is a single man, and when it appears by the  
16 debtor's affidavit or otherwise that the income is [EARNINGS  
17 ARE] necessary for his use or for the use of his family which  
18 is supported in whole or in part by his income [LABOR];

20 Sec. 09.35.085. EXEMPTION FOR CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS.  
21 In addition to the exemptions set out in sec. 80 of this  
22 chapter, the amount which the judgment debtor has been ordered  
23 to pay to a court trustee as child support payments under  
24 Rule 67 of the Rules of Civil Procedure is exempt from execu-  
25 tion if the court trustee has given notice of the court order  
26 to the garnishee before the levy, or if he gives notice to the  
27 peace officer executing the writ as soon as the existence of  
28 the levy becomes known to the trustee but before payment of  
29 the funds to the judgment creditor.
