6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to probationary status of
7 employees in the classified service; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150(7) is amended to read:

11 (7) a period of probation not to exceed one year
12 before any appointment to a position in a given job class
13 becomes [OR PROMOTION IS] permanent, except that any promo-
14 tional appointment to a position in the same job class
15 series becomes permanent at the time of the promotional ap-
16 pointment if at the time of the promotional appointment the
17 employee held permanent status in the position from which
18 he was promoted; however persons receiving promotional ap-
19 pointments to positions not in the same job class series as
20 the position previously held shall serve the prescribed pro-
21 batinary period;

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
23 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
