6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to probationary status of
7 employees in the classified service; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150(7) is amended to read:

11 (7) a period of probation not to exceed one year
12 before any appointment to a position becomes [OR PROMOTION
13 IS] permanent, except that any promotional appointment to a
14 position becomes permanent at the time of the promotional
15 appointment if at the time of the promotional appointment
16 the employee held permanent status in the position from which
17 he was promoted;

18 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
19 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
