6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to residence requirements
7 for hunting, trapping, and sport fishing
8 licenses."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.940(14) is amended to read:

11 (14) "resident" means a person who for 12 consecu-
12 tive months, or for the purpose of qualifying for a resident
13 hunting, trapping, or sport fishing license or a combination
14 of these licenses, a person who for six consecutive months,
15 has maintained a permanent place of abode in the state and
16 who has continually maintained his voting residence in the
17 state, and; in the case of a partnership, association, joint
18 stock company, trust, or corporation, "resident" means one
19 that has its main office or headquarters in the state; however,
20 a member of the military service who has been stationed in the
21 state for the preceding 12 consecutive months is a resident
22 for the purposes of this chapter, and the dependent of a
23 resident member of the military service, who has been living
24 in the state for the preceding year is a resident for the
25 purposes of this chapter, and a person who is an alien but
26 who for three years has maintained a permanent place of abode
27 in the state is a resident for the purposes of this chapter;
