6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to election of members of
7 the Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.08.050(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) Three members of the board shall be elected from
12 the first judicial district, three members of the board from
13 the third judicial district, and three members from the
14 combined area of the second and fourth judicial districts.
15 No more than two members may be resident practicing attorneys
16 in the fourth judicial district when there are two [FOUR] or
17 more resident practicing attorneys in the second district.

18 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
19 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
