6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to air taxi operators."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 02.05.050(d) is amended by adding a new para-
9 graph to read:

10 (3) he shall register his established base of
11 operations with the director, on forms furnished by the
12 director, by August 1, 1966, and may not thereafter change
13 the base of operations except upon proper application to the
14 director showing public convenience and necessity.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 02.05.050(d)(2) is amended by adding a new sub-
16 paragraph to read:

17 (C) an Alaska air taxi operator may utilize
18 in air transportation in all areas of the state east of
19 138° west longitude, any aircraft, other than fixed-wing
20 amphibians, having a "maximum certificate take off
21 weight" (as that term is defined in sec. 293.1 of the
22 said Economic Regulations) of 12,500 pounds or less.
