5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a temporary commission
7 on remote area transportation problems; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. COMMISSION CREATED. There is hereby created a
11 special Temporary Commission on Remote Area Transportation
12 Problems. The commission consists of 20 members: five members
13 from each of the four major senatorial districts - A, E, J and N,
14 as described in the state constitution. The senators at large
15 from Districts A, E, J and N shall select five village council
16 presidents or village mayors from the rural areas of their
17 districts to serve on the commission.

18 * Sec. 2. MEETINGS OF COMMISSION. The members of the com-
19 mission shall meet twice during calendar year 1966 with, and at
20 times and places scheduled by, the legislative council to discuss
21 the problems of their areas relating to air transportation in-
22 cluding mail, cargo and passenger service, and to suggest remedies
23 for those problems. Members of the commission are entitled to the
24 travel and per diem allowances authorized by general law for
25 members of boards and commissions.

26 * Sec. 3. COSTS OF COMMISSION. The travel and per diem costs
27 for the members of the commission shall be included in the
28 appropriation made to the legislative council for the fiscal year
29 ending June 30, 1967.
