6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to competitive bids on  
7 state purchases."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 37.05.230(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) a contract for construction and repairs, or a  
11 purchase of and contract for supplies, materials, equipment,  
12 and contractual services must be based on competitive bids;  
13 an award shall be made to the lowest responsible bidder  
14 after advertising for bids, except that (A) the commissioner  
15 of public works may directly negotiate a renewal or exten-  
16 sion of a concession agreement or a lease involving a con-  
17 cession agreement, whether or not exclusive, for business  
18 operations at fixed locations at state-operated airports  
19 under regulations adopted under the Administrative Procedure  
20 Act (AS 44.62); (B) a bid shall be awarded to an Alaska  
21 bidder if his bid is not more than 10 [FIVE] per cent higher  
22 than the lowest nonresident bidder's; and (C) competitive  
23 bids need not be required (i) for contractual services where  
24 no competition exists; (ii) for sales involving fair trade  
25 items; (iii) when, in the judgment of the purchasing agent,  
26 food, clothing, or medical supplies, or materials for use  
27 in laboratory and experimental studies may be purchased  
28 otherwise to the best advantage of the state; (iv) where  
29 rates are fixed by law or ordinance; (v) for items traded
