6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the registration of  
7 motor vehicles; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.100 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.10.100. GROUNDS FOR REFUSING REGISTRATION. The  
12 department shall refuse registration, or a transfer of regis-  
13 tration, upon any of the following grounds:

14 (1) that the application contains a false or  
15 fraudulent statement, or that the applicant has failed to  
16 furnish required information or reasonable additional informa-  
17 tion requested by the department, or that the applicant is  
18 not entitled to the issuance of a certificate of registration  
19 of the vehicle;

20 (2) that the department has reasonable ground to  
21 believe that the vehicle is a stolen or embezzled vehicle, or  
22 that the granting of registration would constitute a fraud  
23 against the rightful owner or other person having a lien upon  
24 the vehicle;

25 (3) that the registration of the vehicle stands  
26 suspended or revoked for any reason provided by law;

27 (4) that the required tax has not been paid for a  
28 new registration:

29 (5) that the required tax was not paid for the

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previous year because the vehicle was not registered or licensed in accordance with the registration and licensing provisions of this chapter.

\* Sec. 2. AS 28.10.540(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who brings a vehicle subject to registration under this chapter into the state which is registered in another state and who uses the vehicle for pleasure only is exempt from the licensing and registration provisions of this chapter for 90 days after entry into the state. The exemption does not apply after 15 days elapse from the time [IF] the person becomes gainfully employed in the state or takes action which indicates his intention to acquire residence in the state.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

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
