6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of den-
7 tists; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.36.220 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.36.220. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY.

11 If an applicant having the qualifications contained in secs.
12 110 and 210 of this chapter has been engaged in the practice
13 of dentistry for a period of five [TWO] years in a state,
14 territory, district or possession of the United States,
15 immediately preceding his application to practice in the
16 state, the board shall license the applicant without examina-
17 tion.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 08.36.280(a) is amended by adding new subpara-
19 graphs to read:

20 (5) agrees to become domiciled in the area for
21 which the permit is issued; and

22 (6) has not had a license to practice dentistry
23 revoked, suspended or annulled in another state, territory,
24 district or possession of the United States for any cause
25 listed in sec. 310 of this chapter.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 08.36.280(b) is amended to read:

27 (b) The board may authorize a temporary permittee to
28 practice dentistry in more than one city or rural village of
29 the type specified in (a)(2) of this section if the areas

* Sec. 4. AS 08.36.280(c) is amended to read:

(c) The board shall annually renew a temporary permit upon written application of an applicant and upon payment of the prescribed fee if

(1) the applicant is domiciled in the area for which his permit was issued;

(2) the applicant has been found by the board, after an annual inspection of the quality of his services, to have adequately assisted in servicing the dental needs of the area specified in his permit; and

(3) the applicant has not committed an act which is a ground for revocation in sec. 310 of this chapter.

* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
