6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to obtaining approval for
7 airport and road construction."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 02.15 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 Sec. 02.15.205. APPROVAL REQUIRED FOR AIRPORT CON-
12 STRUCTION. (a) No person may construct, reconstruct, relo-
13 cate, or extend an airport, air strip, or private air
14 facility without first obtaining the written approval of the
15 commissioner of public works, as provided by regulation.

16 (b) The commissioner of public works shall not approve
17 the construction, reconstruction, relocation, or extension
18 of an airport, air strip, or private air facility whenever
19 such construction would constitute a hazard to the traveling
20 public or if such construction would otherwise not be in the
21 public interest.

22 (c) The commissioner of public works shall promulgate
23 rules and regulations to effectuate the purpose of this sec-
24 tion which are consistent with standards established by
25 participating federal agencies.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 02.15.240 is amended by adding a new subsection
27 to read:

28 (c) Construction or extension without the approval
29 required by sec. 205 of this chapter is a misdemeanor.

1 * Sec. 3. AS 19.20 is amended by adding a new section to
2 read:

3 Sec. 19.20.090. ROAD CONSTRUCTION NEAR AIRPORTS. (a)

4 No person may construct, reconstruct, relocate, or extend
5 a road or highway within two miles of an airport, air strip
6 or private air facility without first obtaining the written
7 approval of the commissioner of highways as provided by the
8 regulation.

9 (b) The commissioner of highways shall not approve
10 the construction, reconstruction, relocation, or extension
11 of a road or highway under this section whenever such con-
12 struction would constitute a hazard to the traveling public
13 or if such construction would otherwise not be in the public
14 interest.

15 (c) The commissioner of highways shall promulgate
16 rules and regulations to effectuate the purpose of this
17 section which are consistent with standards established by
18 participating federal agencies.

19 (d) Each day of construction or extension without the
20 approval required by this section is a separate misdemeanor
