6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to obtaining approval for
7 airport and highway construction."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 02.15 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 Sec. 02.15.205. APPROVAL REQUIRED FOR AIRPORT CONSTRUC-
12 TION. (a) No person may construct, reconstruct, relocate,
13 or extend an airport, air strip, or private air facility with-
14 in two miles of a federal-aid highway or proposed federal-aid
15 highway without first obtaining the written approval of the
16 commissioner of public works, as provided by regulation.

17 (b) The commissioner of public works shall not approve
18 the construction, reconstruction, relocation, or extension of
19 an airport, air strip, or private air facility if the con-
20 struction would constitute a hazard to the traveling public
21 or if the construction would otherwise not be in the public
22 interest.

23 (c) The commissioner of public works shall promulgate
24 rules and regulations, to effectuate the purpose of this
25 section, which are consistent with standards established by
26 participating federal agencies.

27 * Sec. 2. AS 02.15.240 is amended by adding a new subsection

29 (c) Construction or extension without the approval

1 required by sec. 205 of this chapter is a misdemeanor.

2 * Sec. 3. AS 19.20 is amended by adding a new section to
3 read:

4 Sec. 19.20.090. HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION NEAR AIRPORTS. (a)
5 No person may construct, reconstruct, relocate, or extend a
6 federal-aid highway within two miles of an airport, air strip,
7 or private air facility without first obtaining the written
8 approval of the commissioner of highways, as provided by
9 regulation.

10 (b) The commissioner of highways shall not approve the
11 construction, reconstruction, relocation, or extension of a
12 highway under this section if the construction would consti-
13 tute a hazard to the traveling public or if the construction
14 would otherwise not be in the public interest.

15 (c) The commissioner of highways shall promulgate rules
16 and regulations, to effectuate the purpose of this section,
17 which are consistent with standards established by partici-
18 pating federal agencies.

19 (d) Each day of construction or extension without the
20 approval required by this section is a separate misdemeanor.
