6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to coin-operated devices."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 43.35.090(2) is amended to read:

9 (2) "coin-operated device class 2" means a pinball
10 machine, including a bingo type coin-operated device, horse
11 race machine or other apparatus or device which operates by
12 means of insertion of a coin, token, or similar object and
13 which, by embodying the elements of chance or skill, awards
14 free plays and which contains a device for releasing free
15 plays and a meter for registering or recording the plays so
16 released, but free plays shall not be construed as a thing
17 of value, or with a provision for multiple coin insertion
18 for increasing the odds; class 2 does not include bona fide
19 vending machines in which gaming or amusement features are
20 not incorporated;

21 * Sec. 2. It is the intention of the legislature that this
22 bill shall in no way be considered an attempt or intent to liberal-
23 ize or to exempt the state from the limitations imposed by 15
24 U.S.C. secs. 1171-1178.

25 * Sec. 3. This Act shall not remain in existence beyond
26 June 30, 1969.
