6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to personal exemptions  
7 under the Alaska income tax; and providing  
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 43.20.010(c) is amended by adding a new para-  
11 graph to read:

12 (9) Personal and dependent exemptions allowed  
13 under this chapter for computing individual income taxes are  
14 the same as allowed under the 1954 Internal Revenue Code, as  
15 amended, except that the first ordinary personal exemption is  
16 \$1,800 and the exemption for the first dependent is \$1,800.

17 \* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactively effective from January 1,  
18 1966.

19 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
20 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
