For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to borough and city
elections."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.30 is amended by adding new sections to
read:

Sec. 07.30.045. FILING FOR MORE THAN ONE OFFICE PRO-
HIBITED. A person may file as a candidate for only one
borough or city elective office to be voted on during the
same election day. A person may not file as a candidate
for both a borough and a city office to be voted on during
the same election day.

Sec. 07.30.047. UNIFORM FILING DATES. The assembly
shall fix the opening and closing dates for filing for
election to borough and city offices. The dates shall be the
same for all offices to be voted on during the same election
day. The period between opening and closing dates shall be
not less than 14 calendar days. The closing date shall be
not less than 14 calendar days before the date of the election
for the offices.

Sec. 29.10.114. REGULATION OF ELECTIONS. The council
shall make suitable provisions for municipal and other
elections, and shall appoint three judges and two clerks of
election for each polling place in the city for each election.

ARTICLE 1. ELECTIONS.

Sec. 07.12.050. FILING FOR OFFICE. The provisions of AS 07.30.045 and AS 07.30.047, which place limitations on filing for elective office, apply to home rule boroughs.
