5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registration and
7 licensing of motor vehicles; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.10.160 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.10.160. TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION WHEN ONE
12 VEHICLE IS REPLACED BY ANOTHER [FOR USE IN TRANSPORTATION FOR
13 HIRE]. If a registered vehicle [USED OR DESIGNED FOR USE IN
14 THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS FOR HIRE OR TRANSPORTATION OF
15 PROPERTY, FOR WHICH A LICENSE FEE EXCEEDING \$5 HAS BEEN PAID,
16 is destroyed or permanently withdrawn from [SERVICE IN] the
17 state and replaced [IN SERVICE] by a similar vehicle to be
18 similarly used, the registered owner may transfer the regis-
19 tration plates from the vehicle destroyed or withdrawn to
20 the vehicle replacing it, and the department shall issue a
21 registration card for the new vehicle without the payment of
22 any further tax under secs. 200 - 250 of this chapter. To
23 effect transfer and reregistration

24 (1) the owner of the motor vehicle which is
25 replaced shall pay to the department a registration transfer
26 fee of \$2, file an affidavit showing the fact of destruction
27 or withdrawal, and surrender the registration card to the
28 department;

29 (2) if the weight of the vehicle for which transfer

1 and registration is made exceeds the weight of the vehicle
2 destroyed or withdrawn, there shall be paid to the department
3 for the excess weight a tax at the rate prescribed in secs.
4 200 - 250 of this chapter.

5 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.220 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

6 Sec. 28.10.220. VEHICLES USED BY RANCHERS, FARMERS AND
7 DAIRYMEN. (a) The annual license tax levied on a private
8 motor vehicle under sec. 200(a)(2) of this chapter is levied
9 upon each motor vehicle and trailer which is owned and
10 operated by a rancher, farmer or dairyman if the vehicle or
11 trailer is used to transport the owner's ranch, farm or
12 dairy products from the point of production to market, or to
13 the point of transportation to market or to transport the
14 supplies, commodities or equipment used on the owner's ranch,
15 farm or dairy. Motor vehicles and trailers licensed under
16 this subsection shall be identified as farm vehicles accord-
17 ing to regulations prescribed by the department.

18 (b) If an owner of a vehicle or trailer licensed under
19 (a) of this section owns a motor vehicle or trailer that is
20 not registered and licensed under this chapter because it is
21 operated exclusively on the owner's ranch, farm or dairy and
22 not on the highways of the state, the owner may obtain a
23 farm use permit from the department which entitles him to
24 operate that vehicle or trailer on the highways of the state
25 under the conditions specified in (c) of this section.

26 (c) A farm use permit obtained under (b) of this
27 section entitles a person who owns a motor vehicle or trailer
28 not otherwise registered and licensed under this chapter to
29 operate that vehicle or trailer on the highways of the state

1 for a period of 30 days provided that the vehicle or trailer
2 for which a permit is issued may be used only for those
3 purposes for which a vehicle or trailer may be licensed under
4 (a) of this section.

5 (d) The tax for a farm use permit is three dollars.
6 A farm use permit may be renewed without limit for additional
7 30-day periods.

8 (e) In this section, "trailer" means a trailer which
9 does not exceed a total gross weight of 12,000 pounds.

10 * Sec. 3. Sec. 2 of this Act takes effect January 1, 1967.

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
