5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to appropriate \$300,000 to the  
7 Department of Economic Development for  
8 the construction of cold storage and fish  
9 processing plants and the training of  
10 Alaskans in these plants."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 \* Section 1. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the  
13 general fund to the Department of Economic Development to be used  
14 as matching funds under the Public Works and Economic Development  
15 Act of 1965, P.L. 89-136, for the construction of cold storage  
16 and fish processing plants and for training Alaskans in their  
17 operation. These plants will be located in communities dictated  
18 by economic, engineering, and biological studies of the Depart-  
19 ments of Economic Development and Fish and Game.

20 \* Sec. 2. This appropriation is a part of a project of the  
21 Department of Economic Development known as the Western Alaska  
22 Sea Resources Project, whose objectives are the development of  
23 the sea resources in Western Alaska through: (1) a harvesting  
24 system; (2) a production system; and (3) a marketing system, all  
25 of which are to be accomplished through an on-the-job training  
26 program of western Alaskans in the most modern, economic, and  
27 efficient methods. This \$300,000 appropriation is the first in-  
28 stallment of approximately \$1,150,000 required over a three-year  
29 period for construction of cold storage and processing units and

1 for appropriate training programs.
