2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a Committee for Higher

6 Education in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature must regularly concern itself with
10 the programs and goals of higher education in the state; and

11 WHEREAS, there is an apparent need for an opportunity for
12 those concerned with public and private higher education activi-
13 ties in the state to exchange views, coordinate programs and
14 outline and adjust their goals in the general public interest;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, it would be helpful to the Governor and the Legis-
17 lature if the institutions of higher learning, and representatives
18 of the state government and the general public would cooperate in
19 formulating a suggested long-range plan which would provide the
20 people with the best possible approach to a continuing higher
21 education program of quality and service;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to appoint a
23 Committee for Higher Education in Alaska which would bring to-
24 gether the thinking and talents of representatives of higher
25 education, the public and government in surveying the status,
26 need and prospects for higher education in the state and attempt
27 to coordinate public and private higher education programs in the
28 public interest. The committee is to be composed of the presidents
29 and governing or advisory board chairman of the University of

1 Alaska, Alaska Methodist University and Sheldon Jackson Junior
2 College, the Commissioner of Education, a representative of the
3 business community, and a representative of organized labor
4 designated by the Governor, and a legislative leader from each
5 house selected by their respective house to serve as members and
6 co-chairmen. The committee is to report its findings and recom-
7 mendations to the Governor and Legislature no later than the
8 fourth Monday in January, 1966.
