10 passing of J. Earl Cooper; and

11 WHEREAS, J. Earl Cooper spent a quarter-century in dis-
12 tinguished private endeavor and public accomplishment; and

13 WHEREAS, J. Earl Cooper was an outstanding citizen and lawyer
14 of the Territory and State of Alaska, and served the people of
15 the state in many important capacities; having served as Assistant
16 United States Attorney and United States Attorney in Anchorage;
17 United States District Judge at Nome; member of the Territorial
18 Senate; member of the first State Senate; and Superior Court
19 Judge at Anchorage; and

20 WHEREAS, his distinguished service to Alaska in many capa-
21 cities rendered with a rare combination of dedication and wry wit
22 earned him the esteem of countless Alaskans;

25 the late J. Earl Cooper and the contributions he made to Alaska,
