5 Relating to the depth of the
6 Haines small boat harbor.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, some silting of the bottom of the Haines small boat
10 harbor is apparently caused by improper drainage from the high-
11 way and the embankment behind and above it; and

12 WHEREAS, dredging of the harbor has proved ineffective be-
13 cause the silting from the landward side of the harbor recurs
14 frequently; and

15 WHEREAS, the harbor depth must be sufficient to accommodate
16 fishing vessels operating in nearby waters;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Department of Highways is
18 requested to study the feasibility of installing a culvert or
19 other additional drainage facilities to prevent surface water
20 from eroding the shoreline of the basin, and to take such appro-
21 priate action that is possible within its present appropriation,
22 or if further funds are required, to estimate the additional cost
23 and to report this information to the legislature.
