2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 10
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Endorsing the construction of the
6 Thimbleberry Bay access road.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS there is no public access road to salt water in the
10 area from Silver Bay to Jamestown Bay; and

11 WHEREAS there are a good many acres of land that could be
12 economically developed if there were an access road from the
13 Sawmill Creek Highway to Thimbleberry Bay; and

14 WHEREAS the state is already the owner of a 100 foot right-
15 of-way from Sawmill Creek Highway to both Thimbleberry Bay and
16 Jamestown Bay; and

17 WHEREAS the Sitka Chamber of Commerce is impressed with the
18 sincerity and effort of the owners and occupants adjoining the
19 right-of-way in proposing to do the clearing work themselves;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature endorses the immediate
21 construction of the Thimbleberry Bay access road; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
23 the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; the Honorable
24 Donald A. McKinnon, Commissioner of the Department of Highways;
25 and the Honorable Frank Getman, Chairman of the Greater Sitka
26 Borough.
