4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the employment of
6 residents of the state by oil
7 exploration and development
8 companies leasing state land.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
10 CURRING:

11 WHEREAS there is a sufficient supply of competent resident
12 Alaska labor to provide a large proportion of the labor engaged
13 in oil exploration and development in the state; and

14 WHEREAS this labor force is not now being adequately uti-
15 lized; and

16 WHEREAS the economy of the state would be benefited by the
17 use of the resident labor force;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
19 Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources to require
20 as a condition in any lease of state lands for oil exploration
21 or development that not less than 25 per cent of the persons
22 employed in Alaska by the lessee be residents of the State of
23 Alaska.
