5 Directing a study of juvenile
6 problems and related subjects.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8 CONCURRING:

9 WHEREAS there is a growing concern with the mounting juvenile
10 delinquency problem in the state; and

11 WHEREAS the problem is one of statewide concern requiring
12 examination of its nature and scope and the development of
13 remedies through cooperative action; and

14 WHEREAS the problems of juvenile delinquency in all its
15 facets is of concern to the legislature in enacting laws,
16 developing programs, and providing facilities for prevention,
17 detention and rehabilitation;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
19 make a thorough investigation of juvenile delinquency problems in
20 the state, conduct such public hearings as it may find necessary,
21 and report its detailed findings and recommendations to the
22 legislature at the earliest possible time.
