5 Relating to consolidation of
6 aerial photography functions of
7 the state.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the several departments and agencies of the state
11 necessarily engage in aerial photography, some on an extensive
12 basis; and

13 WHEREAS approximately \$194,000 was spent by the Departments
14 of Highways and Natural Resources during 1964 for aerial photog-
15 raphy and the purchase of prints of aerial photography; and

16 WHEREAS it is likely that a consolidation of the aerial
17 photography functions of the departments and agencies will result
18 in the more efficient and economical provision of this necessary
19 service to the state government;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct that
21 a study be made to determine whether the consolidation of the
22 aerial photography functions of the state departments and agencies
23 in one department or agency will permit more extensive use of
24 existing materials, more effective cooperation with federal
25 agencies engaged in aerial photography, and savings by volume
26 contracting for new aerial photography.
