5 Relating to the determination  
6 and assessment of private  
7 property within the right-of-way  
8 of the proposed Juneau Outer  
9 Drive.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-  
11 CURRING:

12 WHEREAS planning for the proposed Juneau Outer Drive or  
13 Throughway has made uncertain the future of privately-owned pro-  
14 perty along the outer drive route and on the access streets which  
15 will connect with it; and

16 WHEREAS under present plans the assessment of property within  
17 the right-of-way in the second and third stages of the project is  
18 not scheduled to begin until early 1966; and

19 WHEREAS it is desirable that persons whose property may be  
20 taken under the right of eminent domain know as soon as possible  
21 when the tracts must be surrendered and what compensation will be  
22 paid;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to instruct the  
24 Department of Highways to complete its planning of the two final  
25 stages of the Juneau Outer Drive Project, at least in regard to  
26 the required right-of-way, as expeditiously as possible, and that  
27 the assessment of the private property involved begin immediately  
28 thereafter.
