7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS the committee system of the Legislature is so de-
10 signed as to allow for the orderly review of the programs and
11 activities of the agencies of government; and

12 WHEREAS the basis for the programs of each department or
13 agency is its budget request which is made part of the consoli-
14 dated budget document submitted to the Finance Committees of each
15 house; and

16 WHEREAS this system has its limits in that the members of
17 the Finance Committees do not ordinarily sit on other committees
18 and the standing committees reviewing the operating programs of
19 the departments and agencies do not know or have an opportunity to
20 review the present and proposed funding of those programs;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
22 Director, Division of Budget and Management, effective with the
23 convening of the Second Session of the Fourth Legislature in 1966,
24 to provide the chairman and members of each standing committee of
25 the Legislature with the budget requests of the departments or
26 agencies under their jurisdiction as provided for in Uniform Rule
27 22, so that these committees may review the budget requests and
28 report their recommendations to the Finance Committees before
29 final budget action is taken.
