7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-

10 ing of Z. J. Loussac; and

11 WHEREAS Z.J. Loussac came to Alaska many years ago and be-
12 came an outstanding civic leader, public servant, businessman,
13 the greatest philanthropist Alaska has ever had; and

14 WHEREAS he created the Loussac Foundation which has helped
15 immeasurably to further the social, scientific and cultural
16 development of all Alaska, especially the Anchorage area; and

17 WHEREAS the result of Z. J. Loussac's more than 40 years
18 of devoted service to his state and community will be recognized
19 and deeply appreciated by citizens of Alaska for generations to
