8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CON-  
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the executive director of the state Commission for  
11 Human Rights has, as instructed by the Governor, inspected and re-  
12 ported on the problems faced by the citizens of the Pribilof  
13 Islands; and

14 WHEREAS the executive director recommended in his report that  
15 a more complete study, made no later than the first week in May,  
16 1965, be made of the conditions in the Islands by a committee  
17 composed of members representing the Alaska delegation in Congress,  
18 the Department of the Interior, the Alaska Legislature, the execu-  
19 tive branch of state government, the general public, and the news  
20 media, and specifically including members of the Native population  
21 of the state;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that Governor Willaim A. Egan is urged to  
23 appoint a committee in conformity with the recommendation of the  
24 executive director of the Commission for Human Rights; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Committees of the Legis-  
26 lature give immediate attention to the availability of sufficient  
27 funds to cover the expenses of this committee.
