6 the Department of Education to  
7 take the actions necessary to faci-  
8 litate the establishment of a com-  
9 prehensive educational program in  
10 certain schools.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 WHEREAS the need for vocational education in Alaska has long  
13 been recognized, but has not been adequately met; and

14 WHEREAS the Department of Education and other educational  
15 authorities agree that the most effective and economical method of  
16 providing vocational education is by coordination, and to some ex-  
17 tent integration, of vocational programs with academic programs in  
18 a manner that will insure the availability of a comprehensive edu-  
19 cational program, to the extent possible, in each high school; and

20 WHEREAS the legislature has provided a method of funding  
21 state-wide implementation of a comprehensive educational program;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is requested to direct the  
23 Department of Education to establish resource units and guidelines  
24 which may be used by district or state-operated schools to es-  
25 tablish a comprehensive educational program offering the basic  
26 programs necessary to all children, as well as both vocational  
27 and academic programs, and to require the establishment of a  
28 comprehensive educational program in each school which the depart-  
29 ment determines to have the requisite size and conditions.
