3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of a  
6 road to serve the residents of  
7 the Healy River coal fields.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS approximately 400 persons engaged in the coal industry  
10 live or work in the Healy River coal producing areas; and

11 WHEREAS the communities of Suntrana, Usibelli and Cripple  
12 Creek have no road connection with existing highways; and

13 WHEREAS it is only about three miles from the coal fields  
14 road to connect with the Fairbanks-Nenana-Anchorage highway; and

15 WHEREAS the residents of the Healy River coal-producing areas  
16 are now denied the rights and privileges of enjoyment and con-  
17 venience which a connecting road would provide;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Department of Highways assign  
19 a high priority in its highway construction program to the con-  
20 struction of a road from the existing highway across the Nenana  
21 River and commence construction as soon as possible.
