5 Relating to a cold storage
6 system for Golovin, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the village of Golovin is situated in a remote area
9 of the state; and

10 WHEREAS there are available to the people of Golovin abundant
11 supplies of fish and reindeer; and

12 WHEREAS further development of these two valuable natural
13 resources would greatly enhance the economy of Golovin and the
14 surrounding area and provide, at the same time, additional
15 supplies of food for the residents of the area; and

16 WHEREAS the village of Golovin is not able to exploit the
17 natural resources of fish and reindeer to the greatest possible
18 advantage for the community because of the lack of an adequate
19 cold storage system; and

20 WHEREAS a community cold storage facility would not only
21 greatly benefit Golovin and the surrounding vicinity economically,
22 but would aid in the future development of that area of the state;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Departments of Labor, Economic
24 Development and Planning and the Rural Development Agency are
25 urgently requested to assist, by any means at their disposal, in
26 the establishment of a community cold storage and freezer system
27 for fish and reindeer in Golovin.
