1 IN THE SENATE BY BEGICH  
2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION  
5 Relating to the establishment of  
6 a joint library for the Alaska  
7 Methodist University and the  
8 Community College in Anchorage.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS The Community College in Anchorage has a library of  
11 only 22,000 volumes; and

12 WHEREAS the Alaska Methodist University in Anchorage has a  
13 library of only 30,000 volumes; and

14 WHEREAS a 100,000-volume library is necessary for accredita-  
15 tion and for adequate college educational services; and

16 WHEREAS a practical plan for the establishment of a joint  
17 library facility for Alaska Methodist University and the Anchorage  
18 Community College has been proposed; and

19 WHEREAS there are federal grants and matching funds -- some  
20 as high as three dollars for each state dollar -- available for  
21 library facilities such as this; and

22 WHEREAS the plan for a joint library facility has been ap-  
23 proved by the President of Alaska Methodist University and the  
24 Citizens' Advisory Group for the Anchorage Community College;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Regents of the University  
26 of Alaska is directed to conduct a study of the feasibility of the  
27 establishment of a joint library facility, is directed to seek  
28 assistance from Alaska Methodist University in conducting the  
29 study, and is directed to report the findings to the Governor and

1 to send copies of the report to each member of the Legislature  
2 by August 1, 1966.

3 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to Dr. William R.  
4 Wood, President of the University of Alaska; the members of the  
5 Board of Regents of the University of Alaska; Dr. Fred McGinnis,  
6 President of Alaska Methodist University; and the Honorable  
7 William A. Egan, Governor of the State of Alaska.
