7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the 25th anniversary year of the Alaska Territorial  
9 Guard is approaching; and

10 WHEREAS in the years 1942 to 1947 the men of the Alaska  
11 Territorial Guard served the territory and the nation as the eyes  
12 and ears of defense especially in far western Alaska during the  
13 years of World War II; and

14 WHEREAS the men of the A.T.G. served with enthusiasm and  
15 diligence and without pay along the shores of the Arctic Ocean,  
16 the Bering Sea, the Aleutian Islands, and the large river drain-  
17 ages exposed to invasion; and

18 WHEREAS the unique wartime mission and service of the A.T.G.  
19 provided the basis for the formation of the Alaska National Guard  
20 and its famous scout battalions;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature commends the officers and  
22 men of the Alaska Territorial Guard on the approaching twenty-fifth  
23 anniversary of the formation of the organization and requests the  
24 Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska and Commander in  
25 Chief of the Alaska National Guard, to proceed with centennial year  
26 plans to honor the members of the Alaska Territorial Guard with  
27 special medals and certificates commemorating and honoring their  
28 service to Alaska and the nation during the years 1942-1947.
