2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the leasing of space
6 from the Alaska State Housing
7 Authority.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the legislature by Chapter 99, Session Laws of Alaska,
10 1965 provided for the construction and acquisition by the Alaska
11 State Housing Authority of public buildings for lease to the state;
12 and

13 WHEREAS a leasing program has been entered into under the
14 Act; and

15 WHEREAS AS 37.05.280 requires that any additional lease
16 executed after January 1, 1966, which provides for a payment in
17 excess of \$12,000 annually be approved by the legislature; and

18 WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state to enter into
19 the additional leases set out in this resolution;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that use of the space to be provided by leases
21 of the following premises and leases of said premises from the
22 Alaska State Housing Authority providing for payments in excess of
23 \$12,000 annually is approved:

24 The state court and office buildings at Sitka, Anchorage and
25 Fairbanks; the highway department headquarters at Douglas; the
26 state police headquarters at Anchorage; employee housing at Angoon;
27 a one classroom addition at Ambler; a one classroom addition at
28 Stony River; employee housing at Manley Hot Springs; a new jail
29 facility at Juneau; the Community Building located at 150 Third

1 Street, Juneau; Fish and Game headquarters building at Cold Bay;
2 Anchorage District Highway complex; Ninilchik Highway Maintenance
3 Shop; and Bernice Lake Highway Maintenance Shop and Employee
4 Housing.
