SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to a Governor's Fund
for Resolving Alaska's High
Seas Fishery Problems.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the present international treaty has not adequately
protected from high seas fishing the salmon having their origins
in the Bristol Bay area; and

WHEREAS efforts to renegotiate the treaty at the request of
Japan have not as yet been successful; and

WHEREAS efforts to reach and agree on a solution of this
vital problem are continuing but require fuller participation on
the part of the State of Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Joint Finance Committee appropriate,
within the limit of funds available, for a Governor's Fund for
Resolving Alaska's High Seas Fishing Problems.
