10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS Local Boundary Commission submitted to the Fourth  
12 Legislature its Recommendation I of 1966 which related to changes  
13 in the boundaries of the City of Seward; and

14 WHEREAS a recommendation of the Local Boundary Commission  
15 becomes effective unless disapproved by the Legislature within  
16 45 days after its presentation to the Legislature; and

17 WHEREAS Local Boundary Commission Recommendation I of 1966  
18 has now become effective; and

19 WHEREAS representations from the City of Seward opposing the  
20 recommendation were received too late for legislative review and  
21 action through Senate Joint Resolution No. 83;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Local Affairs Agency and the Local  
23 Boundary Commission are requested to re-examine and hold hearings  
24 on Local Boundary Commission Recommendation I of 1966 and submit  
25 any recommendation regarding the boundaries of the City of  
26 Seward it feels appropriate to the Fifth Legislature in 1967 for  
27 legislative review and action.
