6 the Department of Revenue.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the catching and processing of fish and fish products  
9 results in a considerable amount of tax income for the state; and

10 WHEREAS the increase in the take of fish has been reflected  
11 in the income received from the industry; and

12 WHEREAS any legislation affecting the tax income received  
13 from the fishing industry should be thoroughly studied and  
14 evaluated before it receives legislative action; and

15 WHEREAS the Legislature now has before it Senate Bill No.  
16 315, a bill for an Act entitled: "An Act imposing an annual tax  
17 upon processors of fish eggs or fish roe.";

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the  
19 Department of Revenue to study and evaluate Senate Bill No. 315  
20 as it relates to the imposition of a tax on the processors of fish  
21 eggs and fish roe, and report its findings and recommendations to  
22 the Fifth Legislature within 15 days after it convenes in 1967.
